Registration begins June 10th. Sign up and track your reading by using the Beanstack app or website at murrysville.beanstack.org. Along the way, you will receive virtual badges and chances to win fun prizes! After registering, children can pick up a summer reading bag. In your bag will be a paper reading log to use alongside Beanstack if you would like.

READ-TO-ME CAMPERS

Read-to-Me campers (infants-Kindergarten) are encouraged to have their grown-ups read to them for at least 4 hours throughout the summer - that's just about 5 minutes a day, or a picture book a day! Come to the library to pick a free book when your goal is completed.



SOLO CAMPERS
