

KEEP YOUR BRAIN ACTIVE THIS SUMMER - REGISTER FOR SUMMER READING!

Registration begins June 10th. Sign up and track your reading by using the Beanstack app or website at murrysville.beanstack.org. Along the way, you will receive virtual badges and chances to win fun prizes!

After registering, children can pick up a summer reading bag. In your bag will be a paper reading log to use alongside Beanstack if you would like.

READ-TO-ME CAMPERS

Read-to-Me campers (infants-Kindergarten) are encouraged to have their grown-ups read to them for at least 4 hours throughout the summer - that's just about 5 minutes a day, or a picture book a day! Come to the library to pick a free book when your goal is completed.



SOLO CAMPERS

Independent readers (1st-6th grade) are encouraged to track 12 hours of reading this summer while school is out - that's just about 10 minutes a day, or a chapter a day. Readers will receive a free book when their reading goal is achieved!

TEEN TREKKERS

Teen participants, age 12-18 are asked to read a total of **20 hours** and participate in at least **two programs** to complete the challenge. The teen summer reading kick-off party will be on held on **Monday, June 10th at 5pm.**



SUMMER READING PARTY

Children who have completed the summer reading program are invited to the party on **Friday, August 2nd from 1:00-3:00**. Enjoy crafts and games before being amazed by **Magician Steve Haberman** at **2:00**. Kona Ice will also be rewarding readers with a free treat!
